Barbless hooks only No ground bait No hemp tares or bloodworms No carp in keep nets Loose feed in moderation Rod limit 2 per person Dog(s) to be kept on a lead No noise or loud music All pegs must be kept clean and tidy

Conduct & Considerations

Deep water

Parents and/or Carers are responsible for children and/or vulnerable people in their group.

Children under 14 are not permitted to fish unless accompanied by an adult.

No persons to enter the lakes

Hazards & Accidents

Be aware of other anglers casting their lines, maintain a safe distance.

Risk of infection – Please wash your hands before eating and drinking to prevent infection.

Adverse weather can change the ground conditions around the lakes, please be mindful of slippery or wet surfaces. **Accidents should be reported to reception.**

Maximum speed on the park is 10mph

Please do not park on the grass Fishing Times from Dawn until Dusk
