

Touring & Camping at Roach Farm Park

Arrival

Pitches are usually available after 11.00am on the day of arrival, and should be vacated by 11.00am on the day of departure.

Please contact the office if you are expecting to arrive after 4pm.

A £20 deposit is payable on arrival, this is for the security gate fob, and washroom facilities key. Your deposit will be returned to you when you check out, and return the fob and key.

Setting Up

Please set your caravan up inline with the centre of the pitch marker/number.

Guest Guidelines

To ensure that our guests have an enjoyable and pleasant camping experience with us, we ask that you show consideration to your neighboring campers.

Noise should be kept to a minimum at all times and other guests must not be able to hear you, or your music/TV/games after 11.00 pm.

Children (under 18) must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times, in particular around lake areas. **BEWARE - DEEP WATER HAZARD**

Dogs must be kept on a lead, and there be a maximum of two dogs per pitch. Please do not allow your dog(s) to foul the park, and kindly use the dog(s) walking areas around the park.

Portable BBQ's are permitted, but should not scorch the grass. Gazebos and windbreakers are also permitted, but must not be left unattended.

We ask that you adhere to the following park rules:

Max Speed 10MPH

No Ball Games

No Generators

No Open Camp Fires

Keep OFF the grassed banks

Do NOT walk across other guests pitches

Keep your pitch area clean, tidy and hazard free at all times

Fishing License

Fishing Rules

Barbless hooks only

No ground bait

No hemp tares or bloodworms

No nets

No boilies or dog biscuits

No floating baits

Loose feed in moderation

Rod limit 2 per person

Dog(s) to be kept on a lead

No noise or loud music

All pegs must be kept clean and tidy

Conduct & Considerations

Deep water

Parents and/or Carer's are responsible for children and/or vulnerable people in their group.

Children under 14 are not permitted to fish unless accompanied by an adult.

No persons to enter the lakes

Hazards & Accidents

Be aware of other anglers casting their lines by maintaining a safe distance.

Risk of infection – Please wash your hands before eating and drinking to prevent infection.

Adverse weather can change the ground conditions around the lakes, please be mindful of slippery or wet surfaces. **Accidents should be reported to reception.**

Maximum speed on the park is 5mph

Please do not park on the grass

Fishing times are from Dawn until Dusk
